During the terror-filled years of 1973-1976 Sassy Reuven served in the IDF's elite "Red Beret" paratrooper unit. He participated in several covert operations in Israel's mighty struggle against Arab terrorism.

In July of 1976, Sassy participated in the famed Entebbe counter-terrorist hostage-rescue mission code named "Operation Thunderbolt", flying thousands of miles over enemy territory to rescue Jewish hostages being held by terrorists in Uganda.

His story is Israel's story: of courage, endurance, defiance and a willingness to sacrifice it all for the right to live in your homeland in freedom.

Rabbi Mouly was born in Australia, the son of a couple he describes as "hippy parents." While he never went through formal art training, he was always passionate about photography as an outlet of self-expression. About 10 years ago he discovered silk-screen printing, which allowed him to print brilliantly colored images in a style he calls Hasidic pop art.

As a youth rabbi in New Jersey, he sees his work as a way to share his view of the Hasidic lifestyle and dispel images that it is rigid. Mouly challenges preconceived notions. His art allows for an innovative way to exchange interpretations. The artist's work is the perfect platform for him to channel his energetic ideas, which translate into thought-provoking images.

"There's so much color on the inside," he said. "There's so much personality. It really is an approachable way of life."

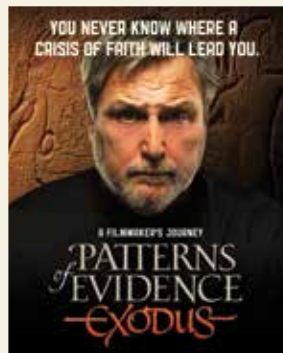

For more than 50 years, the vast majority of the world's most prominent archaeologists and historians have proclaimed that there is no hard evidence to support the Exodus story found in the Bible. Filmmaker Timothy Mahoney begins his in-depth investigation with the question, "Is the Bible just a myth, or did the archaeologists get it wrong?" He decides to tackle this issue with a deliberate scientific approach. After examining the details in the biblical text, he journeys across the globe to search for patterns of evidence firsthand. 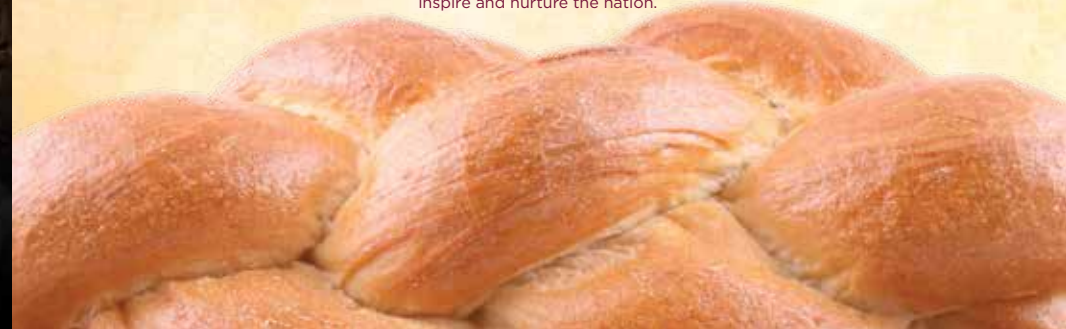
